AN INVITATION TO SING FROM RON SINCLAIR

One of the most common responses I hear when asking someone to join the choir is "I can't sing!" Of course you can. God made us all to sing his praises. But when we don't do it often enough, we usually feel embarrassed when called upon, and so sing too softly to be heard. And in so doing, our worship becomes as timid as our voices. Congregational song is an important part of worship! The Wesleys built the Methodist faith through their hymn texts, set to mostly familiar, singable tunes. They usually didn't have fine accompaniment from organs or pianos, and certainly did not have praise bands amplified as we do today. But they sang. Purely, sweetly, from the heart and from deep in their souls, they sang! You... We... can do the same. And yes. You belong in the choir.
